ELECTION OF DIRECTORS**

I, Natalie Barrantes, the duly appointed Inspector of Election at the Adjourned Annual Meeting of The Oakridge Estates Community Association, a California, nonprofit, Mutual-Benefit Corporation, held on Thursday, July 28, 2022, do hereby report as follows:

- The number of members in good standing and entitled to vote on matters reported below was 352.
- In accordance with the Bylaws, I determined that a reduced quorum of 10% of the voting power was reached.
- I reviewed the registration and all ballots received.
- I received 99 valid, signed ballot return envelopes containing 99 ballots.
- I received 1 additional ballot return envelope that was unsigned and was therefore invalid.
- I determined the authenticity, validity and effect of each of the ballots.
- I determined all challenges and questions in anyway arising in connection with the right to vote.
- One additional ballot return envelope was received unsigned and was therefore invalid.
- The two (2) candidates receiving the highest number of votes will serve for a two (2) year term until the 2024 Annual Meeting. I counted and tabulated the votes as follows:
